# **MYC Cruising**

The 2016 MYC cruise is scheduled for August 5, 6 & 7 to Portsmouth, NH. The city of Portsmouth maintains a public marina in Prescott Park, a short walking distance to downtown and historic Strawberry Banke, making this an ideal location to visit the local attractions.

For those interested in learning more, an information session will be held at 6:00 pm Sunday evening July 10th upstairs at the Club. Lots of information about Portsmouth Harbor, local activities and a cruise guide will be available for those interested in joining the trip.

The distance to Portsmouth from Marblehead is approximately 33/38 miles depending on your course through the Annisquam Canal or around Cape Ann. For those who want to break the trip up, moorings may be available at Annisquam Yacht Club for Thursday August 4th. Dock space has been reserved at Prescott Park for Friday August 5th and Saturday August 6th at \$70 per night per vessel. Electrical power is available for an additional \$10 hookup charge.

#### INTRODUCTION TO SAILING

June 11, 2016 10:00 am to 3:00 pm

Marblehead Yacht Club will close out its 2016 winter/spring boating seminar series with "Introduction to Sailing." The program is suitable for beginning to intermediate adult sailors or teenagers 14 years of age or older.



10:00 am - 12:00 noon: Presenter: Bert Williams. Sailing instructor and former Coastal Sailing School Owner. This 2-hour classroom session will explain how sails capture the wind and propel a sailboat. Finding the wind, sailing theory, points of sail, sail trim, tacking, jibing, reefing, boat nomenclature, rules of the road.

12:00 - 1:00 pm: Lunch is available for purchase on the MYC deck.

1:00 pm - 3:00 pm: The afternoon will bring an opportunity to put the morning's sailing theory into practice. Members of the Marblehead Town Class fleet will bring several "Townie" sailboats to the MYC floats at 1:00 pm. Participants will have a chance to help rig a sailboat and go for a sail through Marblehead Harbor.

The Town Class fleet is growing in Marblehead and conducts an active summer racing program. There will be a briefing on how to participate in the racing program.

This seminar is open to MYC members and the general public.


