MYC Coronavirus Update

While the coronavirus has caused a run on toilet paper along with school, restaurant and bar closings, things at the MYC continue with a few adjustments. Concerned about our members' safety, we will follow the government mandates to eliminate gatherings of 10+ people for the next 60 days. We have canceled events through mid-May including the *Alaska and Antarctica Wildlife* and *Sailboat Race Starting Strategies* Programs, *Nautical Yard Sale*, and *Pot-Luck Meet-n-Greet* event.

We will continue with the April Work Parties but have added 2 more days (4 days total) to facilitate volunteers working in smaller groups (<10) in different areas of the Club; we will not congregate for lunch this time (sorry – no pizza!) There is also a provision to contact Bill Kilham, Club Manager, to arrange a mutually agreed upon time to do some work if you prefer to work on your own. As

the Club is usually empty (except for Bill) we feel the 60 day mandate will have little effect on the normal spring activities at the MYC.

Our March 17 board meeting was held as a conference call. Unfortunately, we can not open up the conference call to all members, as there are technical limitations, and we have invited only the flag officers, board members and Club Manager this time. We will make the minutes of the meeting available to any who request them.

We will continue to monitor the coronavirus situation and the board will re-evaluate every couple of weeks.
