Fourth of July Launch Service

Due to increased holiday traffic, the MYC launch service will adopt a Harbor Zone policy shortly after noon on July 4 and continue as such until the night's closing.

Our three launches will service three separate zones exclusively and members will be required to use only that launch which services the zone in which their mooring is located. Launches and assembly areas will be clearly marked to minimize confusion.

At this time the zones are roughly defined as:

- Inner Harbor: between the causeway and a line from the MYC docks to "Rocket's House".
- Mid Harbor: inside of a line from the Glover landing Docks to Bowden Point to the Inner Harbor line.
- Outer Harbor: our service area beyond.

As always, please try to consolidate crew and guests to minimize extra trips on this, our busiest day of the year. When calling in for a pick-up, specify the number of people in your group. With Patience, Consideration and Cooperation from all, we can ensure a safe and pleasant holiday. And, please leave a light-on for the drivers.
