Dinghy Space Rental Rules

(Revised 3-31-14)

A. Dinghy space locations and Fees

- 1. There will be eight in-water spaces on the south side of gangway at \$250.00 each.
- 2. The Club assumes no liability for any damage, theft, or other loss to a member's dinghy while in or out of the water at MYC.

B. Rules

- 1. In-water spaces are for rigid hull or inflatable dinghies no longer than twelve feet.
- 2. Space assignments must be occupied by the dinghy owned by the member awarded the space.
- 3. Only one dinghy may be secured to a dinghy ring at a time.
- 4. Members must maintain their dinghies in a reasonable condition suitable for marine operation.
- 5. Members must maintain their dinghies in a reasonable condition to prevent damage to other dinghies.
- 6. Lower unit and propellers must be covered to prevent damage to other dinghies.
- 7. In the event the waterfront is closed because of inclement weather, members must remove their dinghies from club floats.
- 8. Fuel, oil or any petroleum product may not be stored on the float.
- 9. Dinghies must be stored in their assigned space at least thirty days per season.
- 10. Dinghy spaces may be "traded" between members with valid dinghy assignments.
- 11. Assignments must be renewed annually with a signed commitment by April 6th.
- 12.To keep their place on the wait list, dingy ring applicants must re-apply in writing each year by April 6th. There is no fee for re-application.
- 13. The Waterfront Committee may revoke a ring permit if a dingy owner does not comply with these regulations.
